Getting Started

Start up the laptop and follow the prompts on the screen.

You will set up and use your own username and password for the laptop you have borrowed. All your information will be wiped from the laptop when you return it.

Install Microsoft Office 365

- 1. Visit https://portal.office.com
- 2. Click through to sign in with your JCC student username & password (i.e. username@sunyjcc.edu)
- 3. Follow the instructions on the website.

Your JCC Username and Password

You can retrieve your username by going to the following page and entering you JCC ID (J#) https://banner.sunyjcc.edu/jccsct_s03/ssj_gateway/

Your initial password is your birth date in the form: MMDDYY. Example: January 7, 1989 would be 010789

JCC requires all students and staff to use their own unique login to access computing resources. Do NOT share your username and password.

The **MyJCC** page is where you access your student email, Blackboard, Banner, DegreeWorks, event calendars and more. This is how JCC communicates with you, so check your email often.

Blackboard

Blackboard is JCC's learning management system. Your instructors use it to distribute course materials and to communicate with you. To access Blackboard, go to the MyJCC page at www.sunyjcc.edu/myjcc.

Banner

Banner is JCC's student information system. You can add and drop classes here, view your student account, update your personal information like mailing address, cell phone, and email address, and view your course information and schedule among other things. You also access your mid-term and final grades here! To access Banner, go to the MyJCC page at www.sunyjcc.edu/myjcc.
